



Range Safety Violation Guide

Safety first, last and always!

Category	Examples		Action(s)
<p>Severe</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Significant risk of injury or death to self or <u>other members</u> • <u>Single infraction</u> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discharge firearm during cold range with member down range • Proceeding down range during hot range, live fire • Handling LOADED/SAFE firearm during cold range with member down range • Handling LOADED firearm off firing line during hot or cold range • Unsafe muzzle position impacting others • Not carrying gun unloaded, action open, muzzle up impacting others 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discharge of firearm forward of firing line unless directed by RSO • Failing to follow direction of RSO • Firing at targets/objects other than those approved by Club • Attitude of member, deemed by RSO, to pose risk to self or those around them • Appearance of impairment 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Requires Board and Member notification by Executive Safety Committee (ESC) • Member's gate card and membership will be temporarily suspended pending review • Potential suspension or loss of membership
<p>Major</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Potential for significant risk of injury to self • <u>Multiple infractions</u> • MAJOR violations can become SEVERE if another member is impacted 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proceeding down range during hot range, no live fire • Not carrying gun unloaded, action open, muzzle up • Performing unsafe/unapproved holster draws during firing • Discharge of firearm during cold range condition • Handling LOADED/SAFE firearm during cold range condition 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unsafe muzzle position • Leaves LOADED firearm unattended • Uncasing firearm on rear bench 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Initial /singular violation requires member be contacted by ESC • Subsequent violations when deemed habitual or involve other members, become SEVERE
<p>Moderate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Moderate risk of injury to self or others • Other actions that pose risk or impact to Club • <u>Multiple infractions</u> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Failing to appropriately use empty chamber indicator • Failing to use hearing or eye protection • Remaining forward of Yellow Line during cold range not handling firearm 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leaving object(s) on front bench • Rapid fire (more than one per second) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warning will be issued from ESC to Member • Habitual infractions could be raised to MAJOR or SEVERE violations

Notes: COLD range is a condition when red safety lights are on following verbal notification; SAFE firearm should be verifiably unloaded with action open and chamber indicator inserted; all members will wear membership card in a visible location while on club property ; **RSO discretion may be used for any violation of the NRA gun safety rules**
