



SLSA Turkey Shoot Nov 19, 2023 9am - 3pm

Details/Rules

EVENTS:

Charge for each event: \$10; tickets sold at Clubhouse and Target Shed

Prizes: Turkey, Bacon or Cash

Shotgun: Quail Walk, Trap Shoot; Compete in groups of 5, 5 shots each, best score wins; **Match Director – Jerry Mattas**

Pistol: 5 shots at 25 yards in groups of 5, best score wins; **Match Director – Gary Grabowski**

Rifle: clay pigeons at 25 yds, if no winner 50 yds, final round 75 yards; Compete in groups of 5, 5 shots each round; **200 yard gong-** no rimfire, compete in groups of 5, 5 shots each, best score wins; **Match Director – Dennis Grey**

Running Deer: Special Purpose Range (SPR); 3 shots at moving cardboard deer, compete in groups of 5, best score wins; **Match Director – Steve Terry**

Archery: **Match Director – Jerry Zalusky**

Note: No shot greater than 7.5 gauge, shot shells for sale (12 ga and 20 ga), no rifle or pistol ammunition for sale, no tactical or home defense shotguns allowed

SAFETY

All shooting activities are under the direction of the applicable Match Director with Range Safety Officers (RSOs) present to ensure a safe shooting environment; waivers to any rule may be granted by the Match Director responsible for that event; unsafe persons will be asked to leave the venue / property

All firearms brought on to SLSA property must be in a case (hard or soft); uncasing / casing may only be done under the direction of the Match Director

Eye and hearing protection are required while on all shooting venues

The four basic firearm safety rules must be followed at ALL times:

ALWAYS treat firearms as if they are loaded

ALWAYS keep firearms pointed in a safe direction

ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until on target and ready to shoot

ALWAYS know your target and what is beyond

No alcohol or alcoholic beverage is permitted by or on any of the shooting venues

Age Requirements

Persons above the age of 18 are welcome on all shooting venues

Minors are defined as persons less than 18 years of age

Minors will, at all times, be fully supervised on the range by parent or guardian; parent or guardian may not shoot while minor is shooting

Minors between the ages of 12 and 18 years of age are permitted on the **shotgun, rifle and pistol** ranges

Minors between the ages of 9 and 12 years of age are permitted on the **rifle, shotgun and archery** ranges
less than 9 years of age are **not permitted on any SLSA range**

FOOD
